

South Northants Action Group (SNAG)

Summary notes of co-ordination group meeting

Held on Tuesday 11 January 2011 at Greatworth School

The matters discussed and actions agreed at the meeting included:

1. An update was provided to all present on various matters, including formal announcement of the route by the secretary of state
2. It was noted that the formal consultation process was due to commence mid-February
3. It had been previously stated that an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) would be published before the consultation process started
4. The roles of the national groups – HS” Action Alliance, STOP HS2 and Transport Sense – were reviewed and it was agreed that SNAG would continue as a local action group but with links to the national groups
5. SNAG roles to lead on various matters were agreed, including:
 - a. Press liaison
 - b. Membership
 - c. Community liaison
 - d. Social media and web site
 - e. Consultation process
 - f. County and local authority liaison
6. It was noted that a “campaign wagon” was available to hire and this was agreed in principle.
7. SNAG to explore engagement with various interest groups on matters of heritage, wildlife, etc.
